About the Grants

Te Rūnanga o Ngāti Kuia recognises that it has a responsibility to support the cultural and sporting aspirations of its members. In order to meet these obligations individuals or groups who require financial assistance may apply to Te Rūnanga o Ngāti Kuia. Te Rūnanga o Ngāti Kuia will consider any applications where it can be demonstrated to have a positive outcome for its members.

Activities may include but are not limited to:

- Cultural
- Sports
- Marae with Ngāti Kuia Affiliations

Applications can be made by:

- Individuals
- Groups
- External agencies

Te Rūnanga o Ngāti Kuia, when considering the amount of assistance, will take in to account:

- the level at which the applicant is participating i.e. local, national, international.
- in the case of group applications assistance will reflect the actual or perceived benefits that will accrue to the Ngāti Kuia community.

Grant Criteria

- Applications made on behalf of a group must be completed by a registered Ngāti Kuia member and the group must contain registered Ngāti Kuia members actively involved in the kaupapa of which the grant is being applied for.
- Individuals making an application must be registered with Te Rūnanga o Ngāti Kuia.
- You cannot apply for funds in retrospect
- You must, if requested provide a profile and photograph for the Ngāti Kuia panui and/or Annual General Meeting
- You must notify Te Rūnanga o Ngāti Kuia Charitable Trust immediately if your circumstances change
- Grants are given as a koha and do not include any GST
- The amount of any grant given depends on a range of factors including the following:
 - A) The putea available at the closing of the grant round
 - B) The number of applications received during a grant round
 - C) Any grants the applicant may of received from Ngāti Kuia within a 52 week period
- All applications must be received in full and on time. No late or incomplete applications will be accepted
