### TE KURA ORA - THE LIVING FEATHERS

The red feathers are treasured among Māori, a taonga of adornment and symbolic of growth. In this context, the feathers are living, the poetical use of the word Kura, being short for Kurahaupō, therefore the three iwi being the moving vessel that cares for the kaupapa, being the oranga fund. To adorn our people so that they can continue to move and develop, lifting their health and wellbeing, still being able to fly.



Te Kura Ora is a combined fund set up by the Kurahaupō Iwi of Te Taihū o Te Waka-ā-Māui (Ngāti Apa ki te Rā Tō, Ngāti Kuia and Rangitāne o Wairau) for the purpose of financially assisting whānau impacted by Covid-19.

We invite whānau who whakapapa to any or all of the three iwi who have been impacted by the advent of Covid-19 and are experiencing challenging financial circumstances to apply for financial assistance via this grant. It is important to note that this fund is intended for whānau whom either cannot access or have been denied assistance from other agencies. Areas that may qualify for support include housing, heating, utilities (e.g. power and phone) or hauora needs.

A committee has been formed with two representatives from each of the three Kurahaupō iwi. This committee has been established to administer the scheme and will have the discretion to consider other whānau needs.

Grants will be made on a per household basis and only one grant per household will be considered in each 12-month period. The first 12-month period commences June 2020.

All payments will be made directly to the supplier on behalf of the whānau and applications must have an invoice, quote or account attached.
